

LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS BOARD

Minutes
January 22nd, 2026

A special meeting of the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board was held at 2:00 p.m. at the LP-Gas Board Building, 3800 Richards Road, North Little Rock, Arkansas.

I. Previous Meeting Minutes:

Motion made by Mr. Paul Cash to dispense with the reading of the minutes from 12/4/2025 and to approve the minutes of 12/4/2025. Motion was seconded by Mr. Terry McCallie. Motion carried.

II. Ferrellgas Waiver:

Mr. Doug Null with Ferrellgas asked for a hose length waiver in order to safely service a large forklift account. Following discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Terry McCallie to approve the waiver request with the following conditions. The hose diameter would be limited to ½" LP-Gas hose, hose management would be utilized, and a remote shut down device would be incorporated. Motion was seconded by Mr. Damon Jackson. Motion Carried

III. Mobile Transfer Trailer: (Tabled at last meeting)

Following discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Paul Cash to approve the use of a Mobile Transfer Unit (Trailer) under the following conditions.

1. The unit must be designated either for filling DOT cylinders or for filling ASME containers.
2. Cylinder filling units must limit pump size to 25gpm and limit the maximum length of the delivery hose to 50'.
3. Industry employees operating a Mobile Transfer Unit must have a BD certification.

Motion was seconded by Mr. Terry McCallie. Motion Carried.

IV. Matador Gas:

Mr. Matt Terry and Mr. David Conley appeared before the board seeking approval for a Class 1 Permit transfer from Stone County Propane to Matador Gas. Matador has purchased the assets and customers of Stone County Propane. Motion was made by Mr. Paul Cash to approve the transfer. Motion was seconded by Mr. Damon Jackson. Motion Carried.

V. Rules:

Director Pfalser shared that the Governor had approved the updated rules and they were ready for formal promulgation. A motion was made by Mr. Terry McCallie to approve the rules as presented and start the promulgation process. Motion was seconded by Mr. Paul Cash. Motion carried.
