


RESPONSIVE SUMMARY FOR LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS BOARD

RULE AMENDMENT

Comes now the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board (LP Gas Board), by and through Daniel Pilkington, Deputy Chief Counsel of the Department of Energy and Environment, and provides this Responsive Summary as required under Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-204(g)(1)(C)(ii)(c):

1. On January 22, 2026, the LP Gas Board initiated rulemaking to amend 15 CAR pt. 270, “State Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board Code,” and approved the amendments to that rule.
2. On January 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, and 26<sup>th</sup>, 2026, the notice of the proposed rule changes, public hearing, and public comment period was published in the Arkansas Democrat-Gazette.
3. On February 3, 2026, at 6:00 p.m., the LP Gas Board held a public hearing regarding the proposed rule changes at the offices of the LP Gas Board, 3800 Richards Road, North Little Rock, AR 72117. No public comments were offered during the public hearing.
4. The public comment period expired on February 23, 2026, at 11:59 p.m., and no public comments were received during the public comment period.
